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## Naming and Dedication of Schools and Facilities

- A. The school board shall select the names for district schools and facilities. District buildings may be named after persons who, in the opinion of the board, have made a noteworthy contribution to education, to the community, or to society. Buildings may also be named after geographic characteristics, after an area in which the facility is located, or after the primary function or use of the facility.
- B. The opening of a new building shall be commemorated by dedication ceremonies to be held as soon after building occupancy as practical. Dedication ceremonies should include participation by the public, members of the Board of Directors, primary users of the facility and those who have been involved with the planning, design and construction of the facility.
- C. A commemorative plaque will be installed in a conspicuous place for public viewing to memorialize the occasion.
- D. The superintendent shall establish procedures and suggested guidelines to be followed in the preparation of recommendations for names of school facilities and dedication activities.
