
Removal/Release of Student During School Hours

The board recognizes its responsibility for the reasonable care of students during school hours. Students will not be removed from school grounds or building thereon during school hours except by a person so authorized according to District procedures. Before a student is removed or excused, the person seeking to remove the student must present to the satisfaction of the superintendent, principal, or designee evidence of his/her proper authority to remove the student.

The superintendent or designee will establish procedures for the removal of a student during school hours.

Prior to sending a student to his/her home for illness, discipline, or a corrective action, the principal or designee will attempt to reach the student's parent to inform him/her of the school's action and to request that he/she come to the school for the student. If the principal or designee cannot reach the parent, the student will remain at school until the close of the school day.

A student may be released to a law enforcement officer in accordance with the District procedure.
